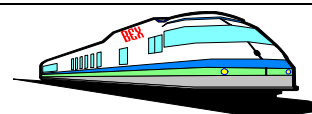

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INTRODUCTION TO BEST (**BEX EXPRESS SECURED TRANSFER**)

BEST is a way to transfer documents using a SECURE, friendly web interface without:


- File size limitations
- File type limitations
- No FTP
- No ActiveX downloads
- 256-bit Secure Socket Layer encryption (SSL)
- Private folders for each user account
- Easy administrator controls to add users

The web interface can also be customized for specific requirements, such as:

- File size limitation
- File type limitations (for example: ONLY PDF files can be uploaded)
- No SSL

HOME PAGE

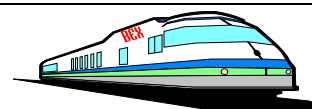
From the home page, log in using the assigned user name and passwords

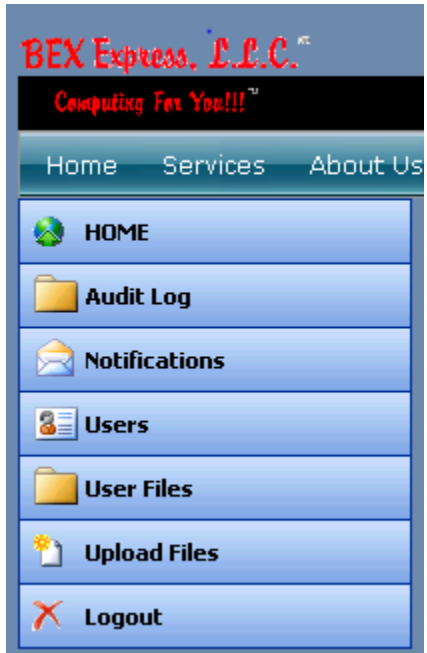

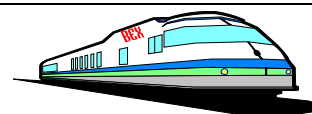
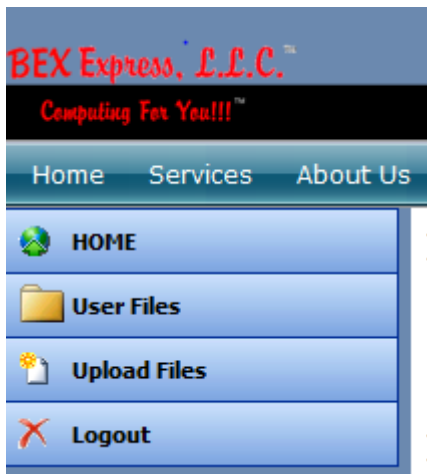
HOME SCREEN (ADMINISTRATOR)

The client screen will be similar to the following screen.



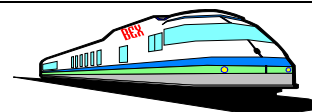
AUDIT LOG SCREEN



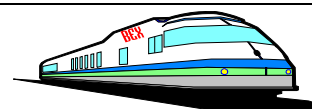



USERS SCREEN

The user screen is where administrators add their clients.

These fields determine the user name, password, notification email (Email address that will receive an email when a file is uploaded to this folder - can be one or multiple email address), the account type (Administrator or Client), Account status (allows to activate or deactivate account), Activate and deactivate date allows for pre defined active and deactivate status.



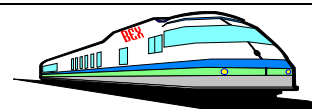

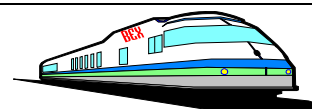
